2. Page 062000-2, Paragraph 2.02.B.: Delete this Paragraph in its entirety and replace with the following:
“B. Interior Woodwork: AWS Custom Grade.”
3. Page 062000-2, Subparagraph 2.02 .B.1.: Delete this Subparagraph in its entirety and replace with the following:
“1. Species; Solid Wood: Select Pine.”
4. Page 085200-3, Subparagraph 2.02 D.3.: Delete this Paragraph in its entirety and replace with the following:
“3. Frame Depth: 5-3/4 inch.”
5. Page 085200-4, Subparagraph 2.04 B.1.a.: Delete this Subparagraph in its entirety, and replace with the following:
“a. Color: Stain to match existing wood trim.”
6. Page 085200-4, Paragraph 2.05 A.: Delete this Paragraph in its entirety.

DRAWINGS

7. Drawing No. A-502, Detail Nos. 3, 5, and 7: Add the following Note:
“Assume 0.02 MBF of wood blocking deterioration replacement for the entire Project.

SUPPLEMENTARY CONDITIONS – CONTRACTOR’S SUPERVISION

This supplement modifies the General Conditions. Where any part of the General Conditions is modified by this supplement, the unaltered provisions of that part shall remain in effect.

ARTICLE 6 – CONTRACTOR’S SUPERVISION

Delete this Article in its entirety, substitute the following:

6.1 The Contractor shall designate in writing competent supervision and/or management representatives as required below to represent the Contractor at all times with authority to act for the Contractor. All Direction given to the Contractor’s Representatives shall be as binding as if given to the Contractor. Individuals listed under this Article shall have the ability to effectively communicate (verbal and written) with all parties associated with the administration/supervision of this contract.

6.1.1 The contractor shall provide a supervisor or working supervisor from the Contractor’s staff who shall be in attendance at the site throughout the active performance of the Work.

6.1.2 The supervisor or working supervisor shall be in attendance at the site throughout the active performance of the Work until Substantial Completion. Upon Substantial Completion the contractor shall provide a supervisor or working supervisor who shall be in attendance at the site throughout the active performance of the Work until Physical Completion. The supervisor or working supervisor shall have the authority to direct the Work, and coordinate the Work of subcontractors and attend project meetings, maintain the project schedule, maintain submittal and approval system, and be responsible for change order/field order responses and negotiations.

6.2 Should the Director deem any employees of the Contractor incompetent or negligent or for any cause unfit for their duty, the Contractor shall dismiss them and they shall not again be employed on the Work.

6.3 Before any part of the Contract shall be sublet or material purchased, the Contractor shall submit to the Director in writing the name of each proposed subcontractor and supplier and obtain the Director’s written consent to such subcontractor and supplier. The names shall be submitted in ample time to permit acceptance or rejection of each proposed subcontractor and supplier by the Director or Contracting Officer without causing delay in the work of the Project. The Contractor shall promptly furnish such information as the Director or Contracting Officer may require concerning the proposed subcontractor’s and supplier’s ability and qualifications, and Minority/Women Owned Business Enterprises Status. Each request for approval of a subcontractor whose subcontract will be valued at \$10,000.00 or more shall also be accompanied by a NYS Vendor Responsibility Questionnaire - For-Profit Construction properly completed and executed by the proposed subcontractor.

6.4 The Contractor’s use of subcontractors shall not diminish the Contractor’s obligations to complete the Work in accordance with the Contract. The Contractor shall control and coordinate the Work of its subcontractors.

6.5 The Contractor shall be responsible for informing its subcontractors and suppliers of all the terms, conditions and requirements of the Contract Documents including, but not limited to the General Conditions, Supplementary Conditions, the Drawings and Specifications, Appendix A, and changes made by Addenda.
