(200 lbs. for FedEx Express Saver or with contract-only FedEx Ground Multiweight rates). It is rated based on price per package and price per total shipment weight. You are billed the lower of the two rates. A 15-lb. average minimum package weight for the shipment applies. For contract-only FedEx Ground Multiweight rates, an average minimum package weight for the shipment applies and varies by contract. FedEx One Rate multiple-piece shipments are not eligible for FedEx Multiweight pricing.</p> <p>FedEx international multiple-piece shipments are billed based on total shipment weight. Package weights are summed to get the total shipment weight. Package rated weights can be based on weights or dimensional weights that were FedEx-captured or customer-provided on individual packages.
