

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Did my entity file for Road Salt (regular Road Salt, Treated Salt Type 1 & Treated Salt Type 2) requirements on the NYS State OGS Centralized Contract delivery schedule for Road Salt?

A: See Attachment 12 - *Delivery Schedule*. Each salt type (ie. Road Salt, Treated Salt Type 1 & Treated Salt Type 2) has its own Tab to reference at the bottom of the Excel workbook.

Q: Who is my Vendor?

A: See Attachment 1 – *Pricing* to determine which Vendor was awarded your county and the salt type you requested during the filed requirements period. Each salt type has its own Tab to reference at the bottom of the Excel workbook.

Q: What is the price of salt (per ton) in my entity's county?

A: See Attachment 1 – *Pricing* to determine which Vendor was awarded your entity's county and salt type that you requested during the filed requirements period. Each salt type has its own Tab to reference at the bottom of the Excel workbook.

Q: How does my entity order salt?

A: See Attachment 1 – *Pricing* to determine who the awarded Vendor for your county and the salt type is. Vendor contact information can be found in the first Tab of this attachment, and in Section 1 – *Introduction* of the Contract Award Notification.

Q: How much salt have I ordered so far this season?

A: This road salt season runs from September 1, 2019 to August 31, 2020. Contact the Vendor for your county and salt type for an accurate count of tonnage delivered.

Q: Is my entity able to get on the NYS OGS Centralized Contract for Road Salt, Treated Salt Type 1 or Treated Salt Type 2 after the Contract is in place on September 1, 2019?

A: Possibly. See Section 3.9.1 – *Delivery Schedule*. Please contact the NYS OGS Contract Management Specialist for assistance with this matter.

Frequently Asked Questions (Cont'd)

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Q: My entity filed for the wrong type of salt. What do I do?

A: Contact the NYS OGS Contract Management Specialist to see if the Vendor(s) are willing and able to switch the type of salt to be provided to your entity.

Q: What does my entity do if the salt load delivered is visibly wet, or otherwise contaminated?

A: The salt load can be rejected at the time of delivery and sent back to the Contractor.

Q: What happens if my entity does not meet its minimum obligation?

A: The Vendor will store the remaining tonnage to meet the minimum obligation for a fee on behalf of your entity. See Section 3.8 – *Minimum/Maximum Obligations* in the Contract Award Notification.

Q: Can my entity buy salt from a different Vendor other than who is awarded to my entity's county and salt type?

A: Yes, however, your entity will still need to meet the minimum obligation with the Vendor awarded on the Contract by the end of this season (August 31, 2020).

Q: How do I use Lot IV – Emergency Standby Road Salt?

A: See Attachment 9 – *Road & Treated Salt Specifications, Section 3 - Emergency Standby Road Salt (Rock & Solar; Lot IV)* for instructions.
