The scope of this Solicitation does not include stand-alone equipment and products such as computers and peripherals, printers or copiers, furniture, industrial tools and supplies, audio visual products, medical equipment, assistive technology products, books, serials or arts and craft supplies unless those products are part of a contractor's general product offering and are to be utilized in conjunction with a contractor's STEM/STEAM or science laboratory based learning systems and curriculum. Industrial or commercial grade 3D printing equipment, robotics or drones that are not intended for an educational setting are also excluded.
